



## WHAT GOES IN THE RED BIN/RED SACK?

### YES PLEASE

- Plastic toiletry bottles, such as shampoo, conditioner and bubble bath bottles
- Plastic cleaning bottles, such as bleach bottles and trigger sprays
- Plastic containers such as fruit punnets, yoghurt pots, cake and muffin trays
- Plastic drinks bottles such as milk, water and soft drink bottles
- Plastic takeaway cartons and lids
- Aerosols, such as deodorant sprays
- Metal drinks cans, such as beer and soft drinks cans
- Metal food tins, such as beans and soup tins
- Clean foil and foil cartons

### NO THANKS

- Plastic carrier bags
- Crisp packets
- Plastic blister (tablet) packs
- Hard plastics, such as children's toys, plant pots, Tupperware containers
- Razors and razor blades
- Empty gas lighters
- Empty gas canisters
- Soft plastics, such as cling film, cellophane, ready meal or yoghurt pot lids, bread bags, cheese wrappings and plastic films
- Compostable, biodegradable or oxydegradable plastic packaging (these should go in your general waste bin)
- Plastic coffee pods
- Polystyrene, including drinks cup lids, and expandable foam packaging
- Sachets
- Sweet and biscuit wrappers

### YES PLEASE

- Card
- Cardboard boxes
- Paper
- Newspapers & Magazines
- Envelopes  
(with or without windows)

### NO THANKS

- Polystyrene
- Any plastic film or packaging
- Wallpaper
- Wrapping paper
- Tissues
- Paper towels
- Kitchen roll
- Shredded paper
- Till receipts
- Padded polyethylene lined envelopes
- Paper and card containing glitter or foil
- Paper and card contaminated with food, paint, oil or grease
- Paper towels, tissues, wet wipes, kitchen roll

## WHAT GOES IN THE GLASS BIN?

### YES PLEASE

- Glass drink bottles
- Glass food jars

### NO THANKS

- Drinking glasses
- Light bulbs
- Broken glass
- Glass and ceramic cookware  
e.g. pyrex
- Light bulbs
- Sheet Glass (including windowpanes, picture frame glass, car windscreens)
- Metal jar lids or bottle tops (which should be placed in the metal stream)
- Crockery (including ceramics and china)

**\*GLASS MUST NOT BE PLACED IN GENERAL WASTE BAGS OR BINS\***

### YES PLEASE

- Fruit and vegetable peelings
- Tea bags, coffee grounds
- All left over food (e.g. pasta, rice, vegetables, baked beans, curry, chips etc.)
- Stale bread and cakes
- Dairy products, breakfast cereal and egg shells
- Cooked and uncooked food
- Meat, fish and bones
- Food past its sell by date

### NO THANKS

- Cardboard
- Shredded paper
- Plastic carrier bags
- Garden waste (including soil)
- Packaging (see if this can be recycled in your red sack)
